

HELEN'S PLACE LAUNCH - 19TH OCTOBER 2011

The Hon Helen Morton MLA unveiled the Helen's Place plaque and congratulated Helen Dullard on 28 years of outstanding community service at the recent launch of Helen's Place.

Helen's Place is the first permanent administration facility for many HCSG administration staff and will strengthen HCSG's footprint within the Mundaring and Swan Shires.
